Summary

1. Mike Brungardt, Kansas Co-Chair, called the meeting to order and began the welcome and introductions.
2. The first order of business was committee review and approval of the March 2010 Aviation Advisory Committee meeting summary.
3. Next, general updates were provided by local airport staff.

Melissa Cooper, Wheeler Downtown Airport, reported that the airport has been dealing with seasonal obstructions related to construction projects in the vicinity of the airport. Downtown Airport has been considering the implementation of more stringent airport access control measures. The TSA has been spot-checking the airports security measures.

4. Ed Young, KDOT, reported that the State Transportation Plan, T-WORKS, was passed by the KS Legislature. T-WORKS includes \$5 million budgeted annually for aviation. The economic impact study for aviation in the State of Kansas has been completed. All Kansas weather information will now be shared with the National Weather Service.
5. Mark Schenkelberg, FAA, related that pending aviation legislation has yet to be passed by Congress. It is possible that the next aviation bill may be approved with a one-year authorization.

6. John Ohrazda, Manager of Lee's Summit Municipal Airport, gave a presentation to the Committee with a status update on development at the Lee's Summit Airport. The presentation included background information on the development of the Airport Business Plan, an overview of its revised Capital Improvements Program (CIP), and details related to the East Side Terminal Development Plan.
7. The meeting was adjourned. The next meeting of the Aviation Advisory Committee is scheduled for Thursday, July 8, 2010 at 1:30 p.m.
