Meeting Summary:

1) **Call to Order**

- a. Since both chairs of the Aviation Advisory Committee were unable to attend, Jim Hubbell, representing the Mid-America Regional Council (MARC), called the meeting to order and began the welcome and introductions.

2) **Approval of Summary**

- a. The first order of business was committee review and approval of the January 2011 Aviation Advisory Committee meeting summary.

3) **Presentation: Kansas City Terrorism Early Warning Asset Protection and Response System**

- a. Bob Kolenda gave an overview of the Kansas City Terrorism Early Warning (KCTEW) Group and their affiliation in the Kansas City Region of reducing threats to all citizens and critical infrastructure.
- b. Paul Godlewski, Department of Homeland Security, then spoke about his role with KCTEW Group, Homeland Security, Suspicious Activity Reporting (SAR) Initiative, and the See Something Say Something Campaign.
- c. Mike Wilson, KCTEW, then gave a brief demonstration of the Asset Protection Response System including a demo of the web version, how it works to eliminate emergency response downtime, and how it can help first responders with location-specific site details

4) **Presentation: An Overview of MARC Emergency Services**

- a. Donn Schoenborn representing MARC gave an overview of MARC, their role, their funding, and the Emergency Services Department and their budget (approximately \$20 million).
- b. Highlighted the Emergency Services Department's coordination with Homeland Security via a regional committee and how they address emergency issues & response through federal & state partners.

5) **General Announcements**

- a. Colin McKee reported that Midwest National Air Center is opening up land for the construction of hangars.
- b. Mike McDonald informed the Committee that Sherman Army Airfield received a state grant to finish paving their runway. Also, the site selection study report for the proposed Leavenworth County airport is nearly complete.

- c. James Green reported that Lawrence Smith Memorial Airport in Harrisonville is getting new equipment and has dirt/grass work to do following recent plowing operations that affected landscaping off runway strips.
- d. All KC Regional aviation facilities are encouraged to contact Mike Wilson regarding participation in the Asset Protection Response System.
- e. State Aviation Day is March 29 in Jefferson City.
- f. The Missouri State Aviation Council/Missouri Airport Managers Association Spring Conference will be held April 13th-15th at the Lodge of the Four Seasons at the Lake of the Ozarks.

- a. The May Aviation Advisory Committee meeting topic will revolve around Airspace.
